Take care about keywords, title and topics

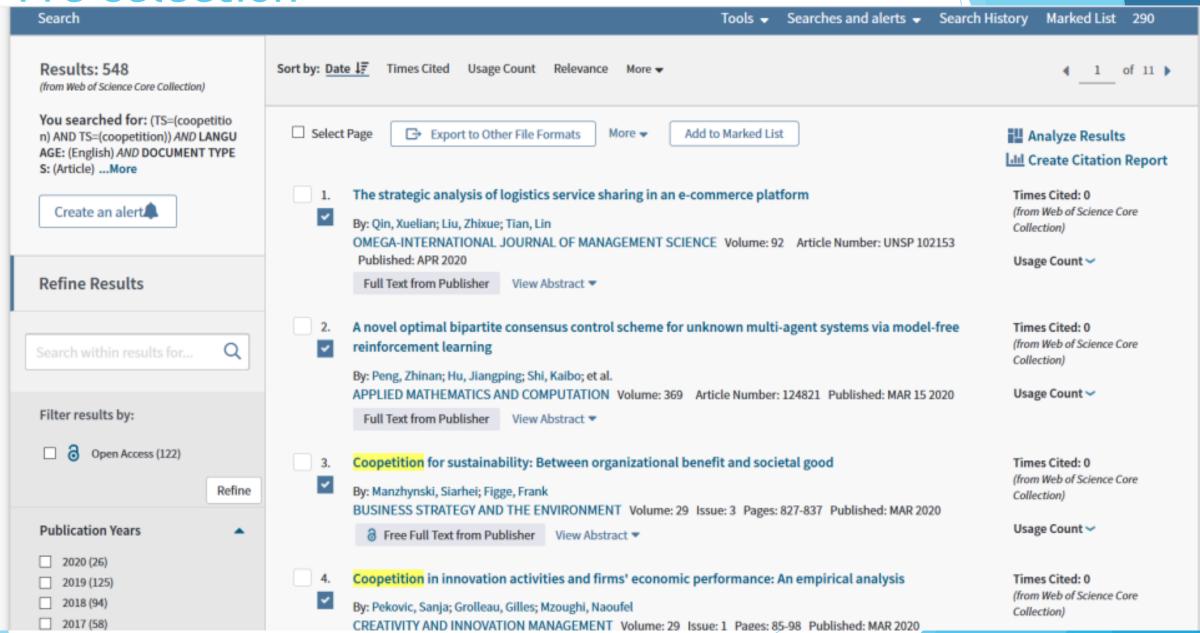
Refine the search several times: publication years, research areas, type of source etc.

Preliminary Analysis could be done

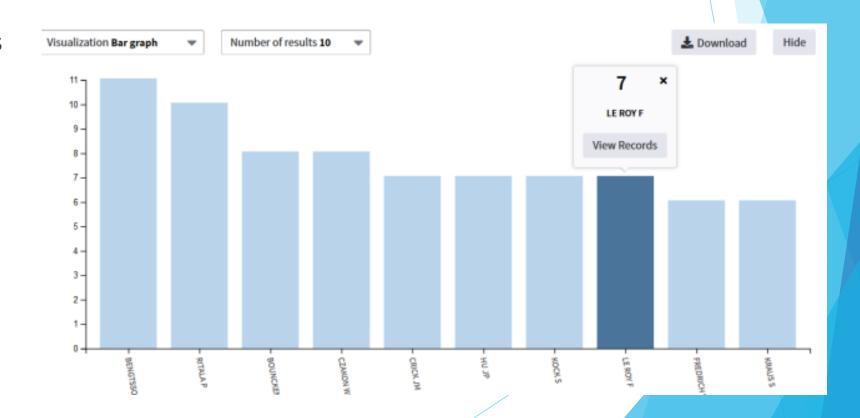
Export the data (All the records)

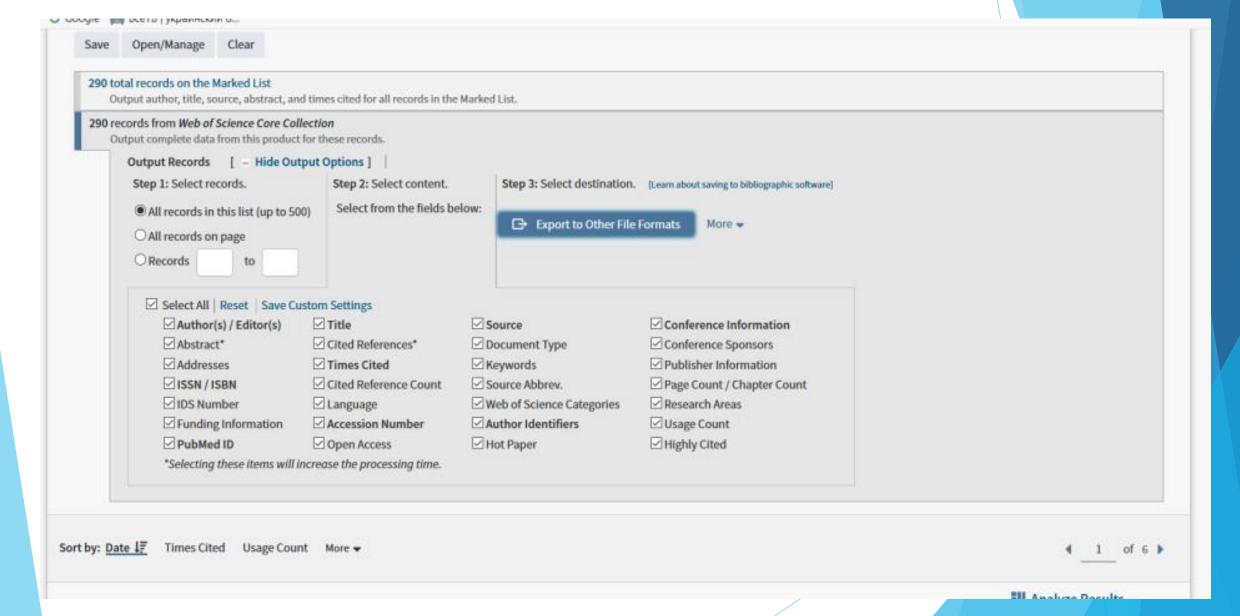

- Affiliation statistics

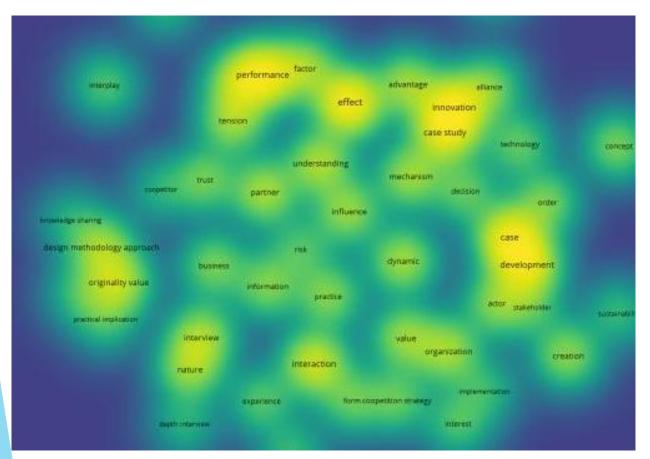


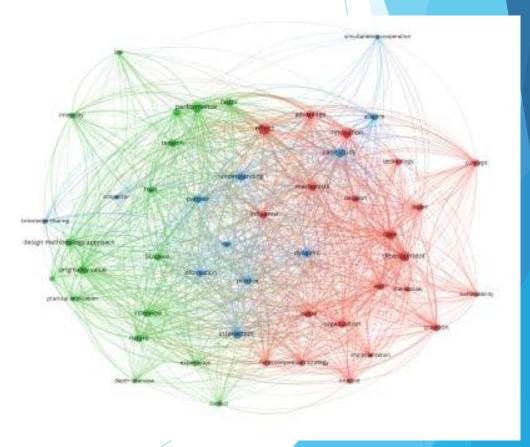
Export of the data



VosViewer Manual is available online

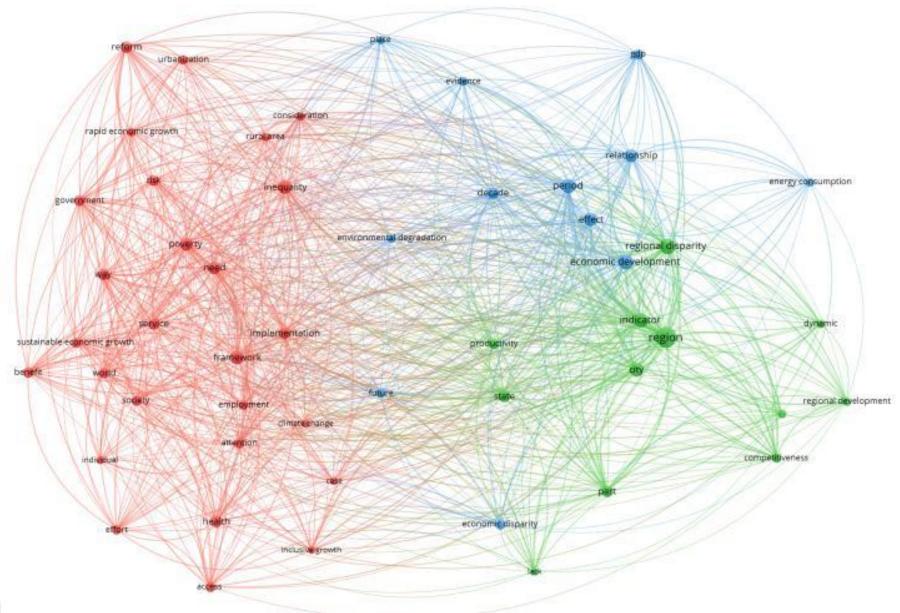
- Create a Map based on bibliographic data (authors network)
- Create a map based on text data (keywords and terms co-occurrence)



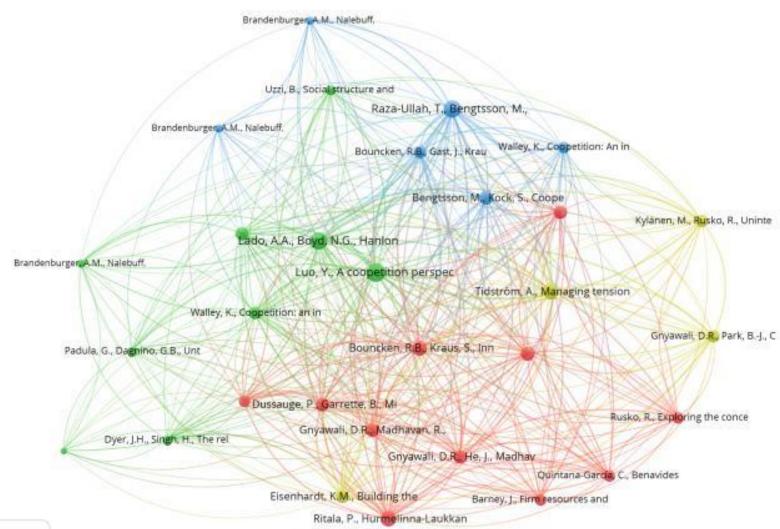

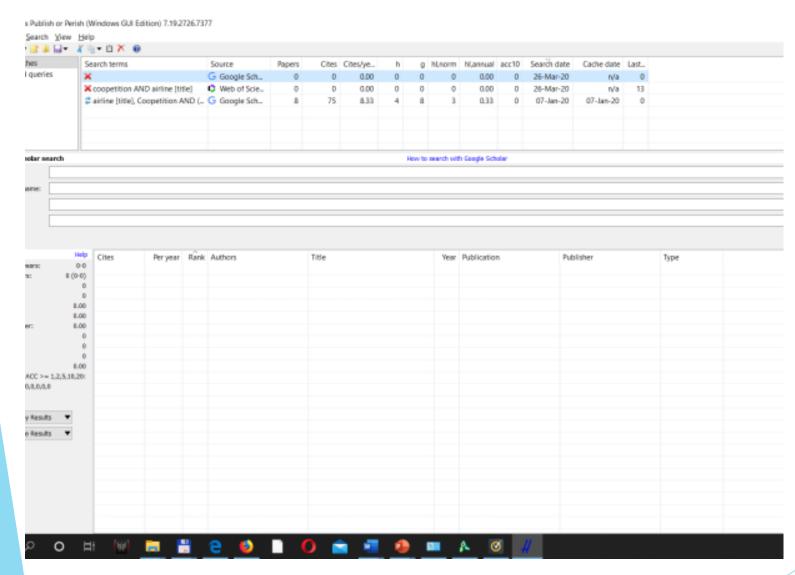
